Festival Regulations

Competitors may use the official accompanists or their own. Please state requirements on the application form. **Please submit a copy of accompaniments with the application**, noting the class number. This also applies to students using their own accompanists.

Accompaniments must be presented in an acceptable manner for the accompanist to use on the day.

Time limits must be strictly observed and in the case of own choice pieces, timings should be submitted on the entry form.

No flash photography is permitted during performances.

Any text/song material containing graphic language or swearing must be submitted in full so that an age appropriate audience can be accommodated. The panel reserve the right to reject entries that the panel deem unsuitable.

Age limits are applicable as of the first day of the festival i.e. Thursday April 26th 2018.

**Please Note, there will be a charge of £2.00 per adult on entry each day.
Two-day tickets will be available for £3.00 and three-day tickets will cost £4.00. Children under the age of 18 will not be charged.**
