NEXT STEPS

Students at other schools will be asked to provide result sheets after publication of GCSEs. Parents and students are warmly invited to discuss predicted grades with the Headmaster or Head of Sixth Form.

For Leadership Awards, students should complete the standard Hill House Sixth Application Form, and the Leadership Scholarship Application Form. Students at other schools may be asked to provide additional information. Applicants for Leadership Scholarships will be invited for an interview to discuss their application in January. Awards will be confirmed after interview.

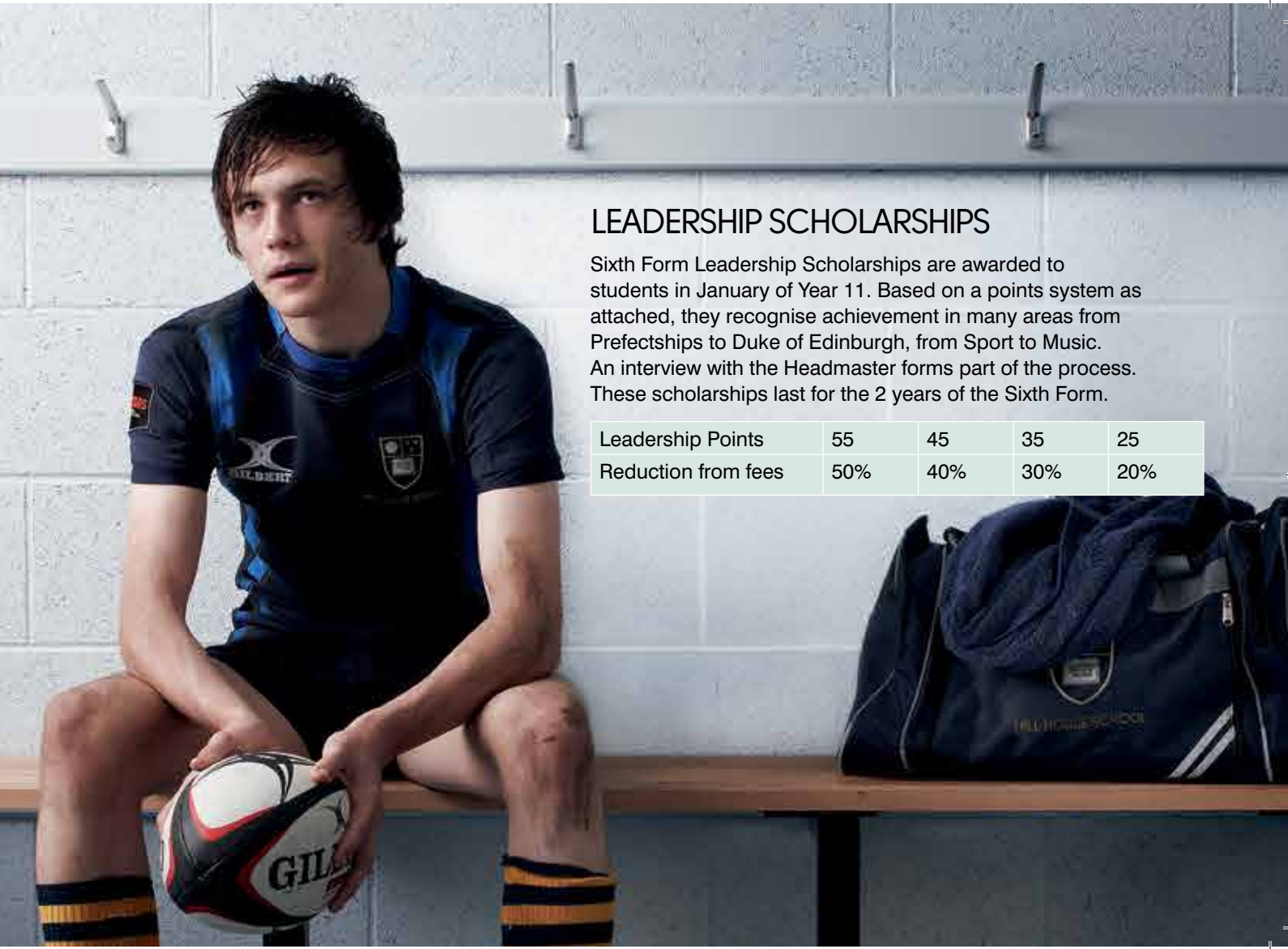

ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIPS

Sixth Form Academic Scholarships are awarded in August prior to joining Hill House Sixth on the basis of GCSE results as indicated below. These scholarships remain in place for the 2 years of the Sixth Form. Outstanding students can expect all the benefits of a Hill House Sixth education at substantially reduced or even no cost.

LEADERSHIP SCHOLARSHIPS

Sixth Form Leadership Scholarships are awarded to students in January of Year 11. Based on a points system as attached, they recognise achievement in many areas from Prefectships to Duke of Edinburgh, from Sport to Music. An interview with the Headmaster forms part of the process. These scholarships last for the 2 years of the Sixth Form.
