HOW TO COMPLETE ACTIVITIES ONLINE

Please find below brief instructions of how to apply online. There is also a document under the activity section on the school website that has more in-depth information. Thank you.

- All parents should be registered to use Clarion Call an email has been sent to parents (who currently do not use Clarion Call) with a link and password in order to activate your account. You will be unable to apply for activities if this step has not been completed.
- On the school website, click on 'Activities.'
- From the drop down menu select the brochure **Lent 2019**. Please have a thorough look through before deciding what activities are available. Some activities have a compulsory list and these take precedent. These will be pre-selected for your child(ren)
- After looking at the brochure, please click on the link that takes you to the Parent Dashboard.
- Click on 'Co-Curricular.' This is where you apply for the activities of your choice.
- There are two sections within this: Available and Enrolled.
- Available this shows all activities that are available for the correct age group. On the far right is a 'tick' icon. If you click on this, it takes you to the next page which shows you the dates that the activity runs and any extra information. Scroll to the bottom and click 'submit.'
- If you then click on the second option 'enrolled,' it will show if your child has been accepted onto the activity (accepted sessions.) If there is a limited number of places available, your child may be put on the waiting list. Again this will be available to see on this page. Once a place becomes available then this activity will show in the accepted column. This will also show up any compulsory activities that your child(ren) may have been selected for these are fixed and cannot be changed/removed.
- This process needs to be completed for each activity that your child(ren) wishes to apply for. This will then complete your online application. If your child(ren) forget the activities that they have requested you can log back in and it will show up on the dashboard.
